CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) volunteers advocate for children who are experiencing foster care due to abuse or neglect. They work alongside judges, attorneys, and child welfare professionals to ensure every child finds a safe, permanent home.



Be the **ONE**

What does a CASA do?



LEARN

Learn about the child and all the adults in his or her life



ENGAGE

Engage with the child during regular visits



COLLABORATE

Collaborate with others to ensure that necessary services are provided



RECOMMEND

Make recommendations regarding the child's placement and needed services, and monitor the child's progress



REPORT

Report what is learned and observed to the court
